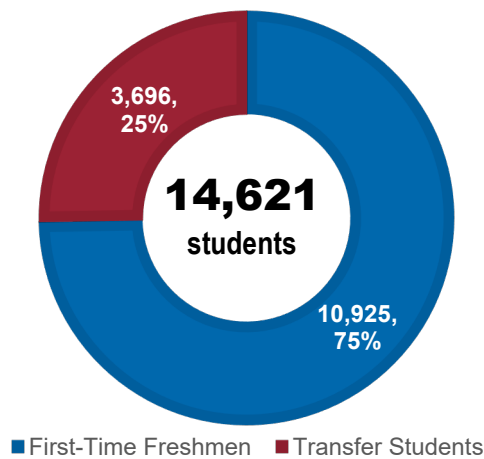

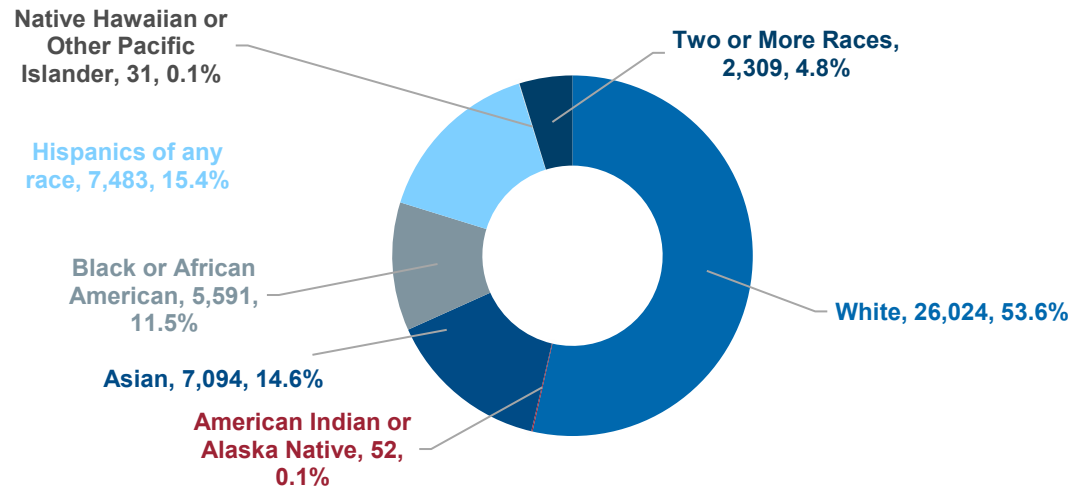

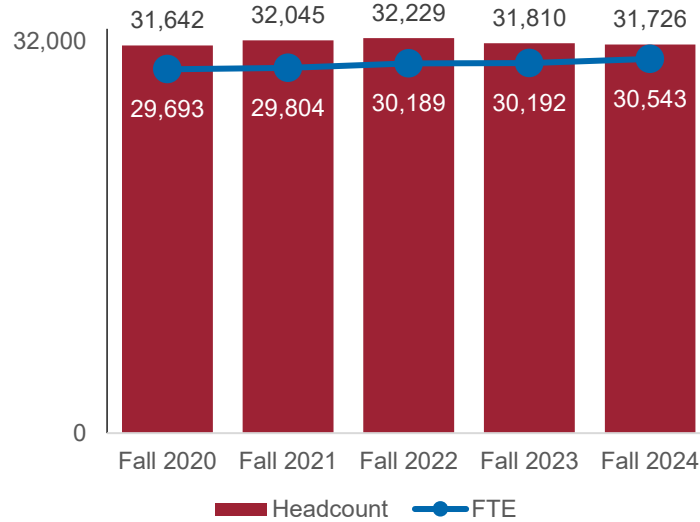
**UNDERGRADUATES BY RACE/ETHNICITY

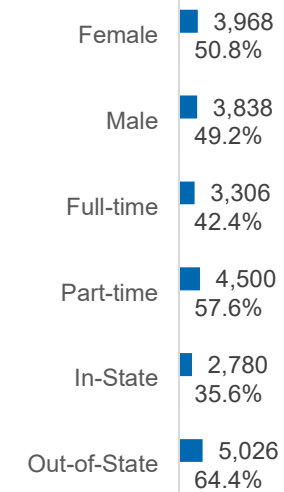

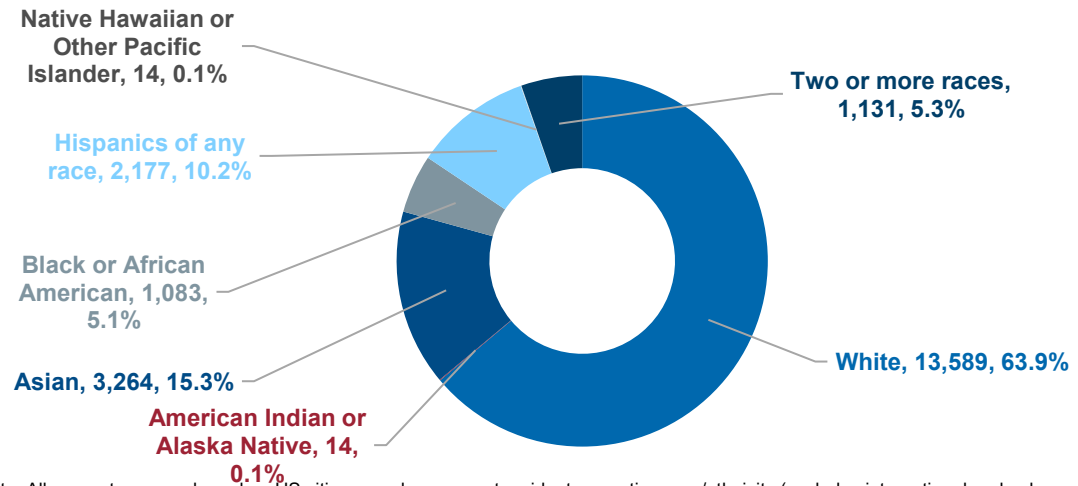

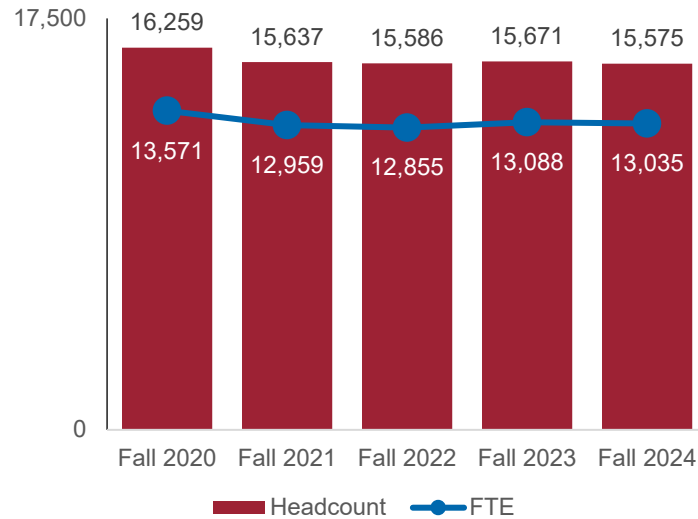

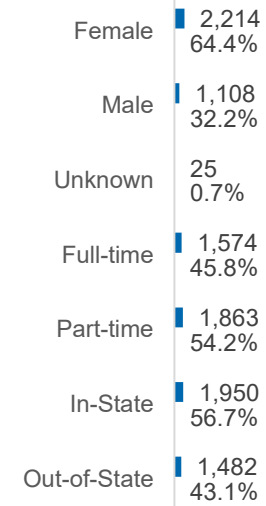

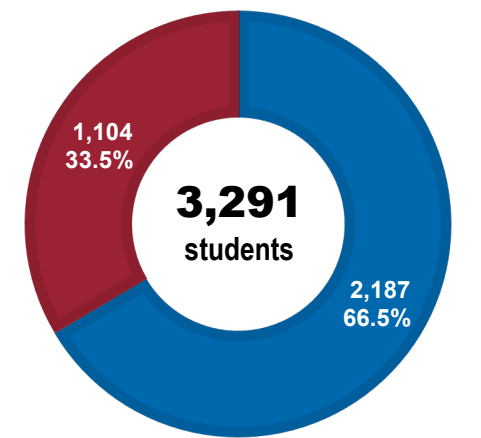

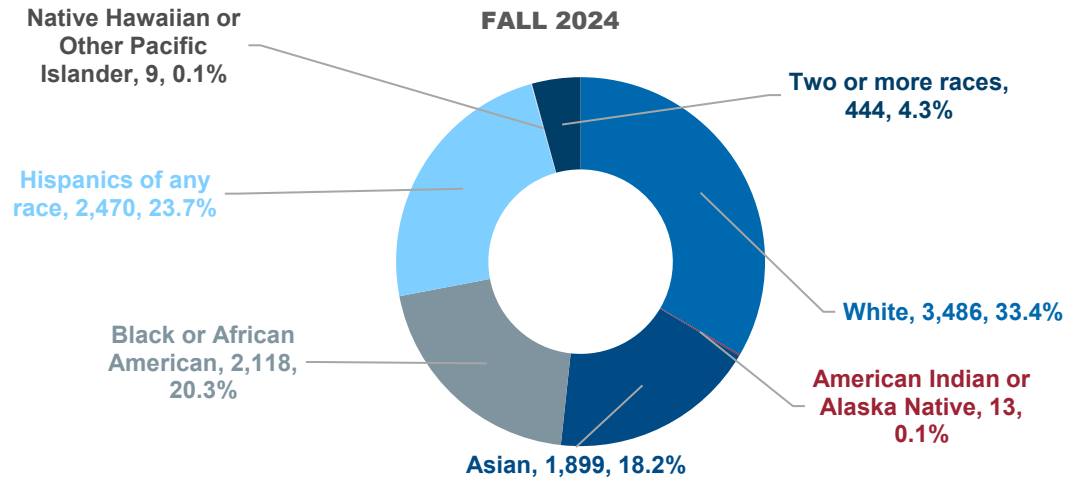

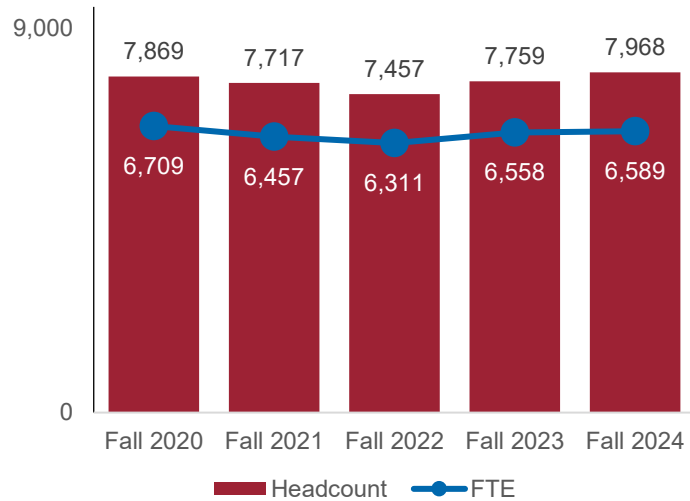
**UNDERGRADUATES BY RACE/ETHNICITY

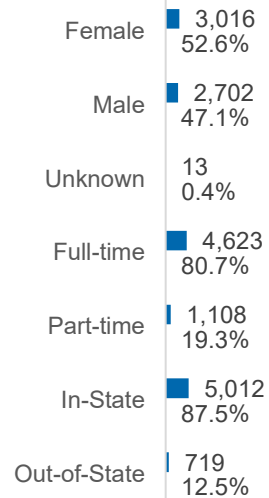

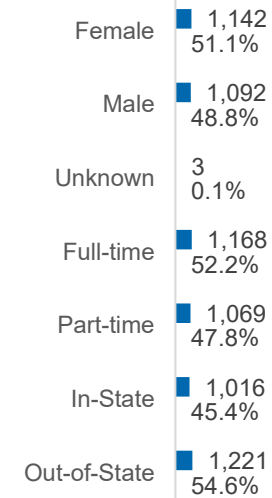

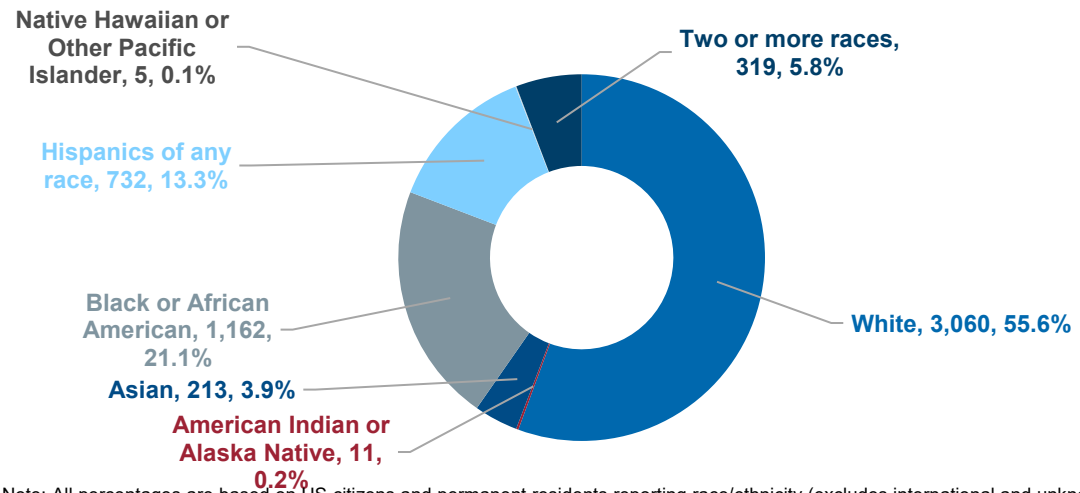

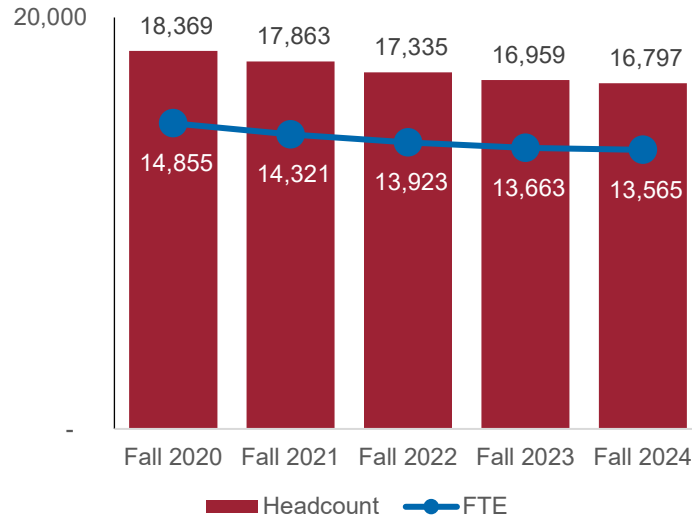
**UNDERGRADUATES BY RACE/ETHNICITY

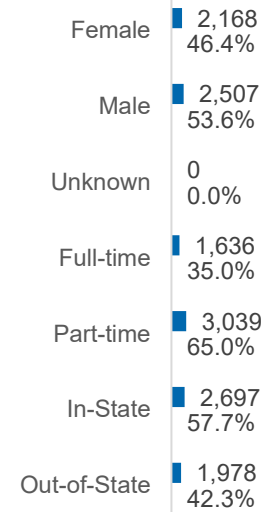

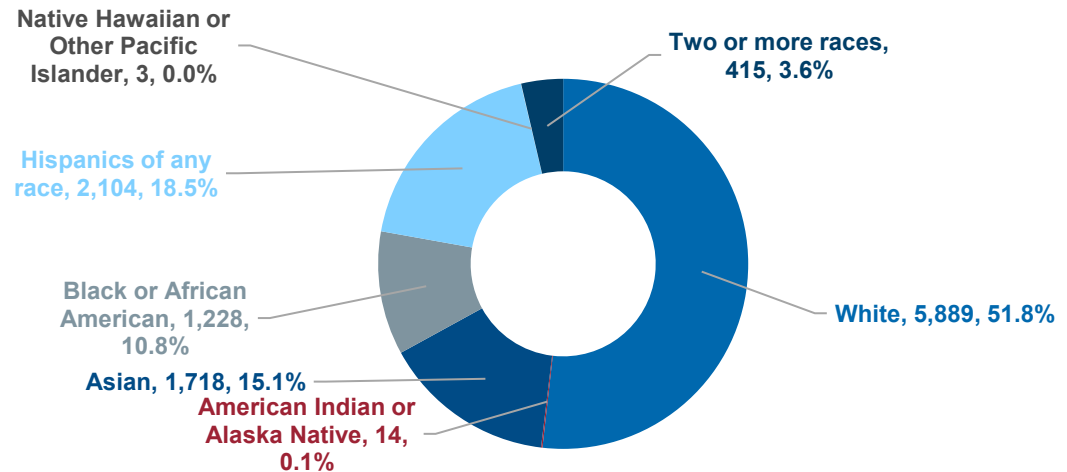

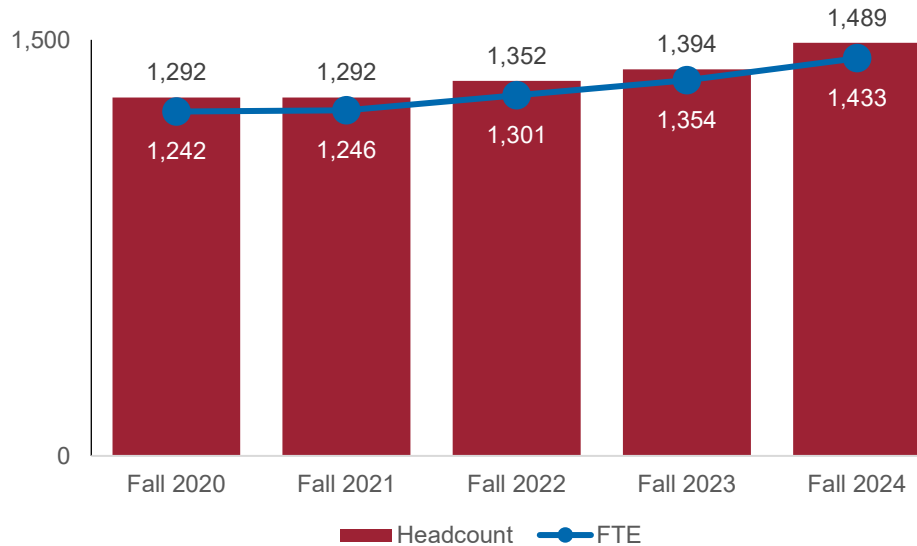
**UNDERGRADUATES BY RACE/ETHNICITY

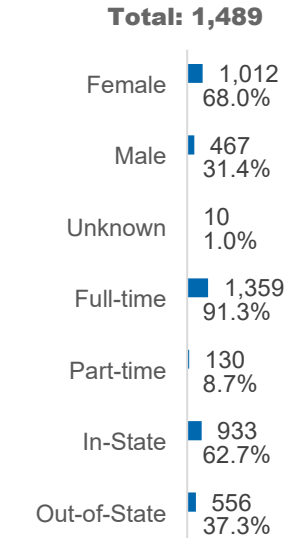

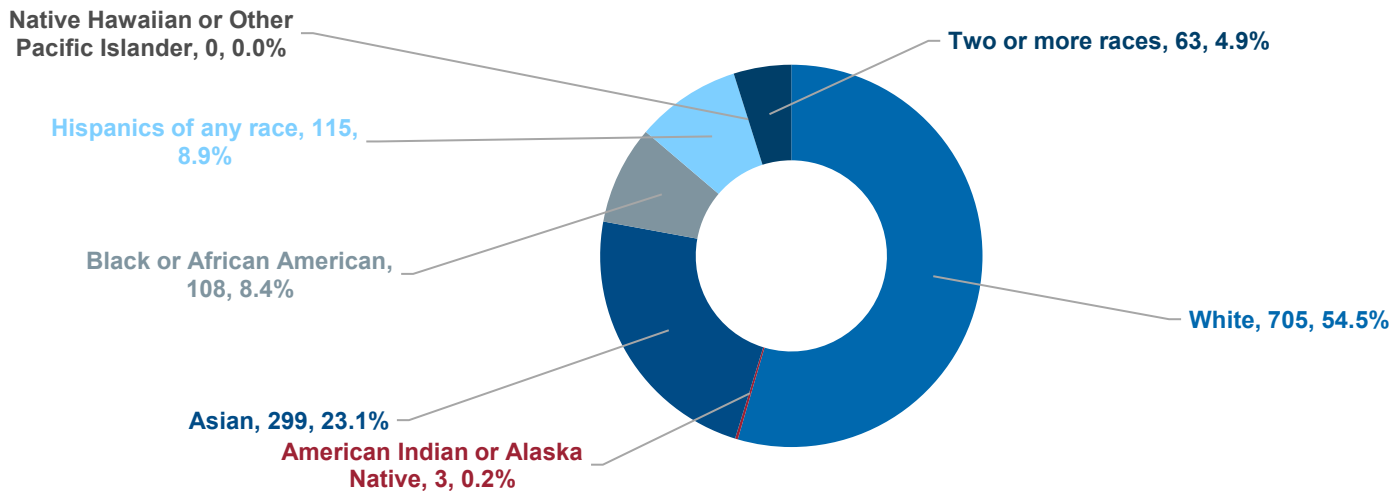
